Psychologist or Psychological Associate

The Redpath Centre opened in January 2008 to address the social and emotional needs of children, adolescents and adults with Asperger Syndrome and mental health concerns through best practices, cross-sector collaboration, teaching and research. Our experienced team of clinicians bring their knowledge of Asperger Syndrome and related symptoms to their work.

We require a Psychologist or Psychological Associate to join our team. This is a unique opportunity to establish or expand a private practice in the context of a group practice setting. The Psychologist or Psychological Associate will be responsible for conducting psychological assessments of children and youth with Asperger Syndrome and related disorders. Some assessment work with adults may also be available or required. We are looking for an individual who can work up to 10 hours per week, or between 10 and 20 hours per week.

The Redpath Centre provides office space, telephone, email and Internet, advertising, and a collegial environment in which to practice. We are centrally located in the Yonge and Eglinton area of Toronto. Office hours are flexible, but are shared with other Associates at the Centre. There is opportunity to engage in research related to ASDs. Clinical supervision is available.

Requirements:

- A PhD in clinical or developmental psychology or a Master's degree in psychology
- Registration with the Ontario College of Psychologists
- At least five years experience assessing children and youth with (mild) Autism Spectrum Disorders, including Asperger Syndrome
- Experience performing psychoeducational assessments and working collaboratively with families and school boards
- Experience working with a multi-disciplinary team
- Experience assessing, providing recommendations and intervention to children and youth with mental health, learning and attentional issues is desirable
